

THE d'ARENBERG CUBE

In 2017, construction was completed on the d'Arenberg Cube, a five storey multi-function centre that appears to be floating among the vines. The d'Arenberg Cube houses the winery's tasting room, a casual food offering, private tasting areas, as well as an immersive art gallery.

The idea to build the d'Arenberg Cube came to Chester Osborn in 2003. Inspired by the complexities and puzzles of winemaking, Chester created the idea of a cube-shaped building. Each of the five levels have been carefully designed to entice and excite the senses, including features such as a wine inhalation room, a virtual fermenter, a 360° video room, and many other tactile experiences.

One of the original wine producing regions in Australia, McLaren Vale boasts stocks of some of the oldest vines in the country dating as far back as 1850. The Mediterranean climate, huge array of soil types and proximity to the ocean with the resultant cooling sea breezes make it an idyllic location for wine grape growing.

Only 45 minutes south of Adelaide, McLaren Vale has 30 kilometres of breathtaking coastline, and over 70 cellar doors to explore in the region. It's an easy drive from Adelaide if you're planning to hire a car, or many operators offer day trips. If you're planning an extended stay, there are a wide range of accommodation options available.
