Bright and youthful in colour with crimson hues. Nose is brooding and complex with youthful fruits, including mulberries and blackberries, purple and blue blossoms, exotic white flowers, smoky reductive characters, and meaty notes. Big, full and powerful palate that is well integrated with slick texture, good acidity and length, and gritty medium to high tannins. Purple, red and white blossoms evident. "An attractive, well-balanced wine with long spices on the end; moreish and youthful," noted one taster. Another thought the wine lacked plushness and flair. "Very food orientated, very moreish and very long," said another.

Vinous

Vivid ruby-red. Highly fragrant, smoke-tinged aromas of fresh dark fruits, incense and lavender are sharpened by a spicy pepper note. Fleshy and broad in the mouth, offering bitter cherry, boysenberry and spicecake flavors that become sweeter with air. Finishes smooth and quite long, showing very good clarity and velvety tannins that sneak in late.
